## Port of Hueneme/City of Port Hueneme Washington, D.C. Joint Advocacy Trip

**Possible Dates: September 12 (travel day) - 15 (travel day). Meetings on September 13 and 14**

**Purpose: Highlight value of strategic partnership between the Port of Hueneme and City of Port Hueneme and discuss common infrastructure and policy priorities.**

**Notes** from June 21st meeting with Letitia about September trip include the following points.

POH purpose and expectations for the September visit with federal agencies, associations and Congress

Meeting roles for officials from the City of Port Hueneme, city's expectations for trip, city's role with development of meeting schedule

Total number of POH and city officials making trip, names and titles, transportation arrangements with Arnow, group dinner arrangements for one night, hotel selection

Confirm final list of agency, association and Congressional meetings

Develop list of discussion topics and talking points for meetings with agencies, associations and Congress – schedule for two days of meetings can include the discussion points under each meeting listing

Determine if there is enough interest or relevance to include a meeting about trade issues (Asia, Latin America)

Begin requests for meetings first week of August. Prepare discussion topics and action requests in mid-July.

#### Federal Agencies and Associations

- Environmental Protection Agency – Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, Inflation Reduction Act programs of direct benefit to city and port
- U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – beach nourishment, shoreline protection, South Pacific Division/LA District climate change activities, coastal resiliency

- Department of Transportation – intermodal funding programs, regional infrastructure accelerator program, Opportunities for defense communities and installations in the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and the Inflation Reduction Act
