1. General Plan Community Workshop

The Mayor welcomed the community to the General Plan workshop. Community Development Director introduced Rincon and RRM Design Consultants who led the presentation and conduct the General Plan Community Workshop to allow the public to provide feedback on ideas and concerns for the future of the City of Port Hueneme.

Consultants provided a General Plan update overview indicating the plan would be encompass the next 20-30 years. The last update to the City's General Plan was in 1988.

Consultants provided a project timeline and detailed the following:

Focus Areas:

- Identify location for required housing units
- Incorporate environmental justice and social equity
- Foster economic development and new jobs
- City beautification and enhancing the beachfront
- Incorporating climate action and adaptation

Regional Housing Needs Allocation:

- Updated housing element for sixth cycle
- 125 new units

Consultants provided ample opportunities for community participations through polls, chat features, and question and answer sessions.

Mayor Hernandez thanked the consultants, staff, and community for their work and participation.
